- Exhibition** Saturday, September 4th to Saturday, October 2nd, 2010
- Media** All Media: paintings, drawing, photography, pottery, sculpture, stained glass, wood, and weaving.
- Eligibility** Artists 18 years and older, residing in West Virginia, Kentucky or Ohio. Original works only, created by the artists themselves. All works must be the original expression of the artist and completed since 2008. Copied works and class work where assistance has been given are NOT acceptable. All works must be hand delivered.
- Presentation** Accepted work, excluding free standing pieces, must be suitably framed and wired for hanging. The museum reserves the right to eliminate works it deems unacceptable. Due to limited exhibition space, art work should NOT exceed 3 feet by 4 feet.
- Entry Information** Entry is \$25.00 non-members, \$20.00 members of TSAA. Each artist may enter up to 2 works of art. All entries must have a completed entry form and labels attached to back of each work.
- Prizes** Purchase Awards will be for \$200.00 and up. Best of Show Award \$200.00, Merit Awards of \$100.00 each and Honorable Mention awards of \$50.00 each will also be given.
- Sales** Every effort will be made to encourage sales of works. Works "Not for Sale" must be marked NFS. TSAA will process all sales and retain a commission of 10%. Does not apply to purchase awards.
- Insurance** All works accepted will be insured by the Museum during the exhibition period. The value of NFS must be declared for insurance purposes.
